2. Roll Call/Determination of a Quorum:

8. Lyon County staff report: Doug Green reported the purchase of a new mower was approved by BOCC. There was a rash of vandalism at Pioneer Park, Penny Park, and the Rodeo Grounds during spring break. New swing installations at Pioneer Park and Our Park should be completed by next week. Next swing installations will be at Dayton Ball Field, Como Park, and Silver City. New fence at Mark Twain was finished at a cost of \$6,770. The new score board for Dayton Ball Field was \$7437.21.
9. Long range planning for capital improvements for regional parks: Reviewed existing priority list. Updated Master Plan for Mark Twain Regional Park was identified as a top priority as well as getting an update on the progress of obtaining BLM land for the Silver Springs Regional Park.
