

# Community Notification

## Use of Explosives at Anaconda Copper Mine Site

Beginning the week of May 31<sup>st</sup>, Atlantic Richfield's contractor, WESCO, will be using explosives to bring down a steep "high wall" associated with a large, crushed rock pile located north of the pit lake at the Anaconda Copper Mine Site. The blasting program will be conducted in accordance with all Federal, State, and Local regulations, and is part of the ongoing reclamation program at the site. Detonations will be monitored for ground vibration, dust and sound generation. A total of 2 detonations are planned over a 1-month period of time. Each detonation will last for 1-2 seconds. Advance notifications of the two subsequent blasts will be made once the dates and timeframes are determined. This will be the last planned blast for this phase of project.
