PUBLIC NOTICE

Visitor Restrictions

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has advised people to take precautions in light of the coronavirus outbreak and that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.

To minimize exposure to COVID-19 and avoid disruption to critical court functions, the Third Judicial District Court has imposed visitor restrictions on its courthouses in Dayton, Fernley and Yerington.

Effective immediately, the following persons shall not enter the courthouses in Dayton, Fernley and Yerington:

1. Persons who have traveled to any foreign countries within the last fourteen (14) days;
2. Nevadans who have traveled to another state or other persons who have come into the State of Nevada from another state in the last fourteen (14) days;
3. Persons who reside or have had close contact with someone who has traveled to any foreign country or another state within the last fourteen (14) days;
4. Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
5. Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with the coronavirus;
6. Persons with apparent symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, severe cough, or shortness of breath.

Anyone attempting to enter in violation of these protocols will be denied entry by Courthouse Security.
